Carrara, located at the foot of the Apuan Alps, is the world-famous capital of marble, from which the stones were sourced to sculpt timeless statues and decorate the capitals of Europe.

However, the marble tradition of Carrara is not just about artists and masters; it is also the story of miners who, with courage and determination, have worked in the quarries for centuries. Even today, millions of tons of marble and semi-precious stones are extracted and processed every year.

The marble quarries are located in a breathtaking landscape, suspended between the sea and the peaks of the Apennines. On board a Land Rover Defender, you will travel along narrow, winding dirt roads to reach the highest points of the quarries, where you will see modern machinery used for marble extraction and discover the techniques employed in the various stages.

After a brief stop in the second valley for a refreshing glass of Prosecco, it will be time to enter the second underground quarry, an almost alien environment that will fascinate even the most sceptical.

At the end of the exploration, a cold lunch featuring delicious local specialties, including the famous IGP Colonnata lard, awaits you.
