The perfect setting, surrounded by vineyards, olive groves, flowers, and vegetable gardens.

With the help of a local Tuscan woman, you will learn the traditional secrets of our cuisine as well as cooking techniques. This is where you will roll up your sleeves and start making our homemade fresh pasta and preparing a delicious truffle sauce for lunch. Success is guaranteed.

Before sitting down on the terrace to enjoy the fruit of your labor, you'll explore the farm's wine cellar. Wandering around the property, you will be guided through all stages of production, harvest, fermentation, and aging. They will tell you about the characteristics and regulations that make Chianti Classico and all of its denominations so special. Then, you will head to the veranda where lunch, prepared by you, will be served, all paired with their wines and spirits.
